

In preparation for a visit to the British Museum, I purchased this to make the best use of my time, and found this book to be a good investment. The layout of the book gives just enough information about the major artifact sections of the entire museum, that the first time visitor should be able to

plan routes through the facility to see and learn about these world class artifacts in a timely way. Very little background information is given about the artifacts, so if you are not up to speed on many of them, other museum resources, from audio guides to other literature, would be needed.
