I loved this book! And I'm still going back to it to learn new stuff all the time! I'm not even really a hardcore metal guitar player, but just love the mix of heart and technique that you see in great metal playing - so I wanted to make metal part of my guitarist vocabulary and this book was a perfect book for that. But my \*favourite\* part of this book is the riffs. Oh, the riffs! They are Rob's original works styled after great metal players - and they sound fantastic. I've found many of them technically challenging - but having the audio really gives you inspiration to get there! The fact they are original also gives you a ton of inspiration for your own creativity. The material is put together in comprehensive and great accessible format - starting with the 60/70s stuff and rolling forward to modern metal - and the recorded material that you get with the book is just top notch audio. There's great stuff here on metal rhythms, scales, technique (tapping, etc) - and the riffs are all done in different styles of metal to give you a really good rounding across the genre. I particularly enjoyed the shout-outs in each section to real music that uses this technique (eg some songs that use Phrygian mode). Rob's done a stellar job with this book. Go grab a copy!

This is a great book for professional or amateur musicians who are serious about metal guitar playing and want to gain a more thorough knowledge of the style, its origins and performance practices. The book is comprehensive and begins with a section on the beginnings of metal guitar playing eventually delving into more complicated modern metal playing involving odd meters and rhythms. There are plenty of clearly notated examples with tab notation as well. If you don't read music, there is a primer at the beginning of the book to get you through the basics, but even if you don't work through that, there are good quality accompanying audio samples for all of the licks and guitar lines/progressions presented. A very detail oriented and thorough study book that puts the 'head' into 'Metalhead'. I would say, if you love playing metal or want to learn more about the style, then after going through this book, you will not ever have to fear being labeled a 'hack' and have a real knowledge base to draw from when playing in the style.

This course had me fooled at first. The pages looked like recycled paper and the book did not come with a companion CD. After a couple attempts I managed to download the audio clips and began at the beginning. I'm now starting chapter 4 and so far the content has been excellent. I'm even keeping a log on practice time and exercises covered. This is a great package for beginner and intermediate alike. I highly recommend it to anyone who is serious about being a better metal guitarist.!!
