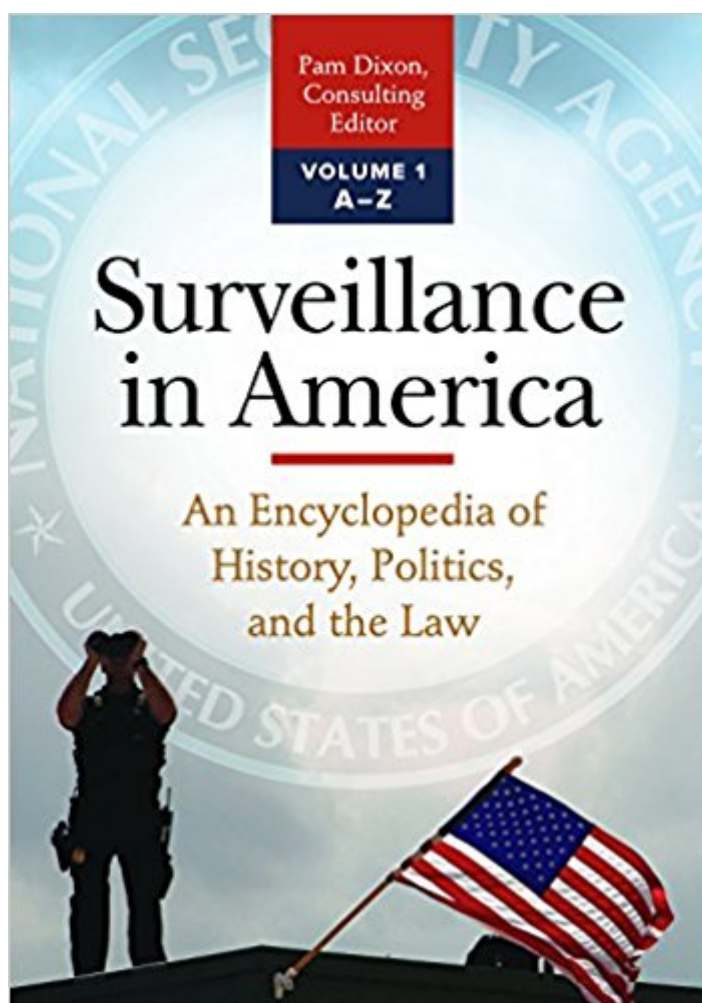


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# Surveillance In America [2 Volumes]: An Encyclopedia Of History, Politics, And The Law
