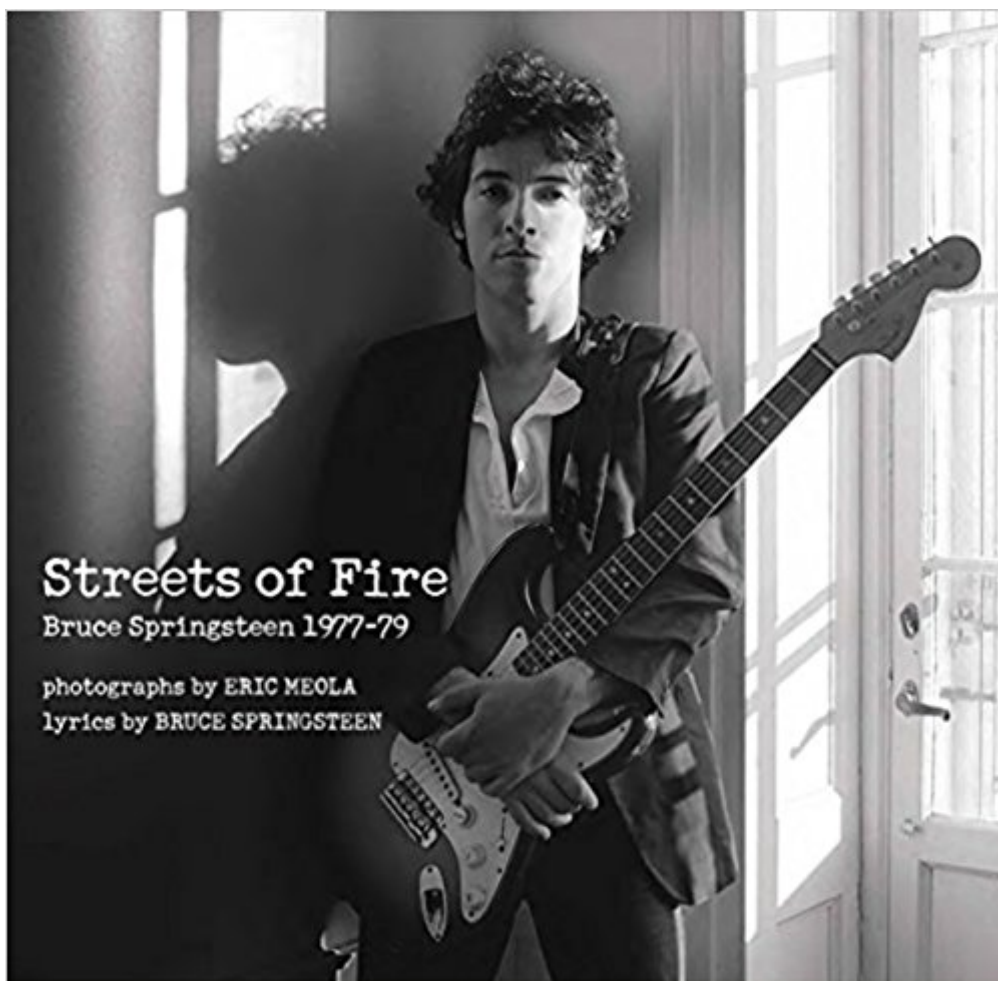

The photographs go so much deeper than the black, white, and infinite shades of gray of this beautifully produced book. They reveal Bruce in the early stage of a remarkable career, full of brooding complexity, a man with so much to say, so much for us to hear. The photographs defy the term "portrait;" they do what most photographers only dream of: convey a sense of the personality of the subject.
