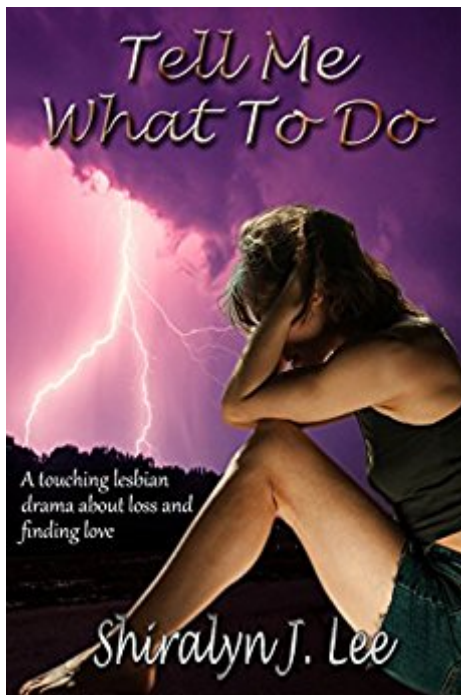


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Tell Me What To Do

It's a great angle in the writer's work, that the main character is either reluctant or has some kind of struggle to overcome. It lent the story a kind of

depth and as a reader there was a good level of empathy, as the story is very sad. I won't say how it ends only that I approve, and I quite liked the introduction of the phobia and how it became an important feature of the struggle and in the end, the reward.

Many readers will think John's an arse, but the time between the death of the baby and him becoming a jerk is off page, so I found myself unable to dislike him.
