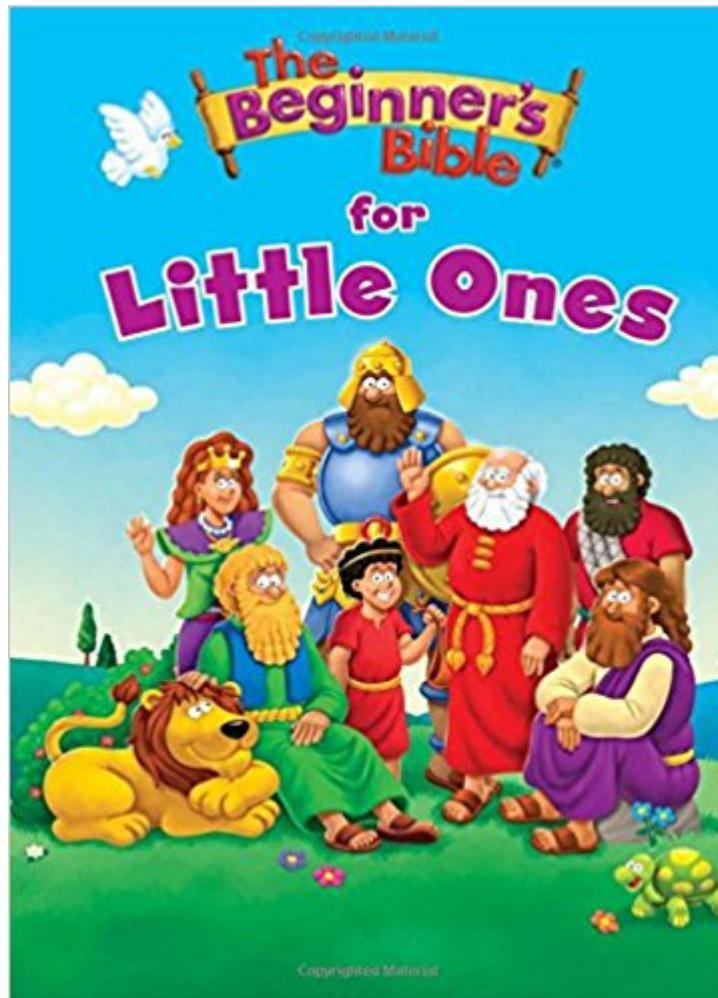

The Beginner's Bible for Little Ones is perfect for children ages 2-4 years old. However, you can read it to children that are younger or have older children read it as well. There are eight stories taken from both the Old and New Testament of the Bible which includes; The Beginning, Noah's Ark, The Mean Giant, Daniel and the Lions, An Angel Visits Mary, Baby Jesus is Born, Jesus Feeds Thousands, and Jesus is Alive. The stories are in a simplified format that younger children can understand before learning all the details and information about each to take to heart as they get older. Each of the stories is four pages long. The text is simple to read with no vocabulary that would be too difficult for early readers or for little ones to not understand. The illustrations do not cover the

entirety of the pages. I feel the images depict what's going on very well. I like that each of the stories has the scripture references right under the title of where you can find it in the Word of God. The scripture references will help little ones learn not just where to find the story but to learn it comes from in the Bible. It's called a Bible but I think it should have a different title with the words stories in it. Overall, not a bad offering in the least bit. If you are expecting a full Bible or more than eight stories you'll be surprised though. It's a nice choice for a few stories for young children. Since my children are grown, I wanted to see what I could recommend for parents with younger children, and The Beginner's Bible for Little Ones is a great addition. This Bible is extremely sturdy and rugged and would be great for a child who is learning how to hold a book without destroying it. There are a number of very basic Bible stories in this Bible. What I really enjoyed were the pictures which allows the parent to fill in the blanks as the child asks questions or seems interested. The parent can play out the story as much or as little as they wish. There are many of the favorite Old Testament and New Testament stories in this Bible. It would be a fun Bible to get new parents who often are not thinking about what Bible to read to their children. It would be excellent for children ranging from infant to maybe 4 years old. I would highly recommend this Bible. This book was provided at no cost in exchange for an honest review.

Part of The Beginner’s Bible series, this thirty-two-page board book with a padded front cover and rounded corners targets young children from four to eight years old. The book covers eight well-known stories taken from the Old and New Testaments of the Holy Bible. With a few mildly scary or violent scenes, it would best be read out loud to non-readers or beginner readers who like to look at pictures due to their limited reading comprehension level. The book presents four stories each from the Old and New Testament that are four pages each. A title with referenced Bible verses listed and several paragraphs explain the stories. Having colorful, easy-to-decipher illustrations, the cartoon designs show expressive characters on almost every page; there is ample room under each for a few sentences written on white backgrounds.~ Why
This approximately 5 by 7 by 1-inch chapter book has short, to-the-point stories written in a

positive way. Although not all the stories told give pertinent facts (Jesus's birth does not explain Herod killing baby boys, and it does not mention Christ died for our sins), it generalizes the events. The stories cover creation, Noah's ark, David and Goliath, Daniel in the lions' den, the angel visiting Mary, Jesus's birth, Jesus feeding the five-thousand, and Christ's death and resurrection.~ Why Not ~Those who do not want to promote teaching a child about Bible stories will pass on this book. It may be too advanced for beginner readers due to the two and three syllable words. Some children get upset viewing the pictures of the dead giant, Daniel being put into the pit, or Jesus carrying His cross, but they are not too graphic.~ Who ~No information is given on the illustrator.~ Wish ~This reviewer wishes all pronouns of God were capitalized for reverence.~ Want ~If you are looking for a book of 8 short stories from the Bible that are four pages each, this would be a good selection for a young one. Thanks to Zondervan for furnishing this complimentary book that I am freely reviewing.

I recently received the updated version of the Beginner's Bible and was excited to see they also had a Beginner's Bible for Little Ones to review. This one comes in board book style with a padded front. There are 8 Bible stories included and the book is 30 pages long. The pictures take up most of the page to draw in the reader. They are done well and in a similar style to the others in the other versions of the Beginner's Bibles I have seen. This one is a great resource for younger children (likely around ages 4 and under). The downsides for me are that there only 8 stories included and there is no table of contents. If you are looking for a book to read at bedtime or throughout the day then the number of stories would not be a problem. In terms of using for a Sunday School type setting, this will be a great addition to utilize in a preschool class alongside other storybook Bibles. Overall, I think this is a fun introduction to Bible stories for little ones!
