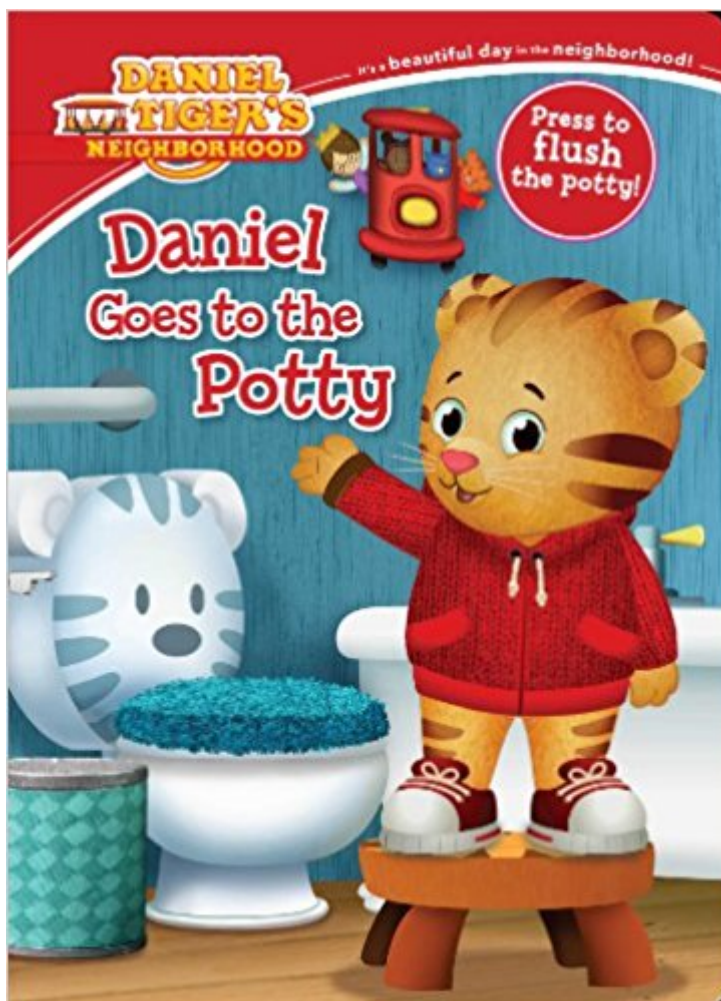

I ordered this for my son who is in the process of potty training right now. It is a board book with a button that you can push on each page to make a flushing noise. It follows the second half of the potty training episode of Daniel Tiger's Neighborhood where he visits Music Man Stan's Music Shop and needs to go potty. It addresses the issue of using the restroom in public places so toddlers know that there are toilets everywhere they might go. I was hoping for something a bit more instructional for my two year old who has not mastered the potty yet and has some anxiety about using the toilet. He likes the flushing button but the sound quality was poor. He thought it was the

sound of pee going into the toilet. Kids who love Daniel Tiger will like this book but parents looking for an instructional book to model potty time behavior should choose something else.

A must have for your potty training Daniel Tiger enthusiast. Fun to read while sitting on the potty. I also downloaded Daniel Tiger's potty song, and used Daniel Tiger reward stickers for each poo or pee on the potty. Daniel Tiger and timing helped my toddler potty train in just under a week.

My two-year old LOVES this book. We also have the Daniel Goes to the Potty DVD, which has the same plot and song. We read this most times she is sitting on the potty. She loves to sing the song, and press the button. She's my third child, we've been through a lot of potty books, and this seems to be the biggest hit yet. My older kids (7 and 6 years old) also know the song, and seem to find this book fairly entertaining, since we've all heard it thousands and thousands of times :-)

My son loves all things Daniel Tiger, so when it came to potty training this was my go to book. It is a good book, that kind of combines all the potty stories into one and you get to use the flushing button to help Daniel flush the toilet. I would certainly recommend it for your little Daniel Tiger fan

My daughter is 22 months and beginning to potty train. She loves Daniel Tiger so this book has been great. She loves pushing the potty button and hearing it flush. It's a cute book, I just wish the sound was louder. I wouldn't call this a great book to teach children about the potty and how to go but it's a nice resource to have that appeals to her interests.
