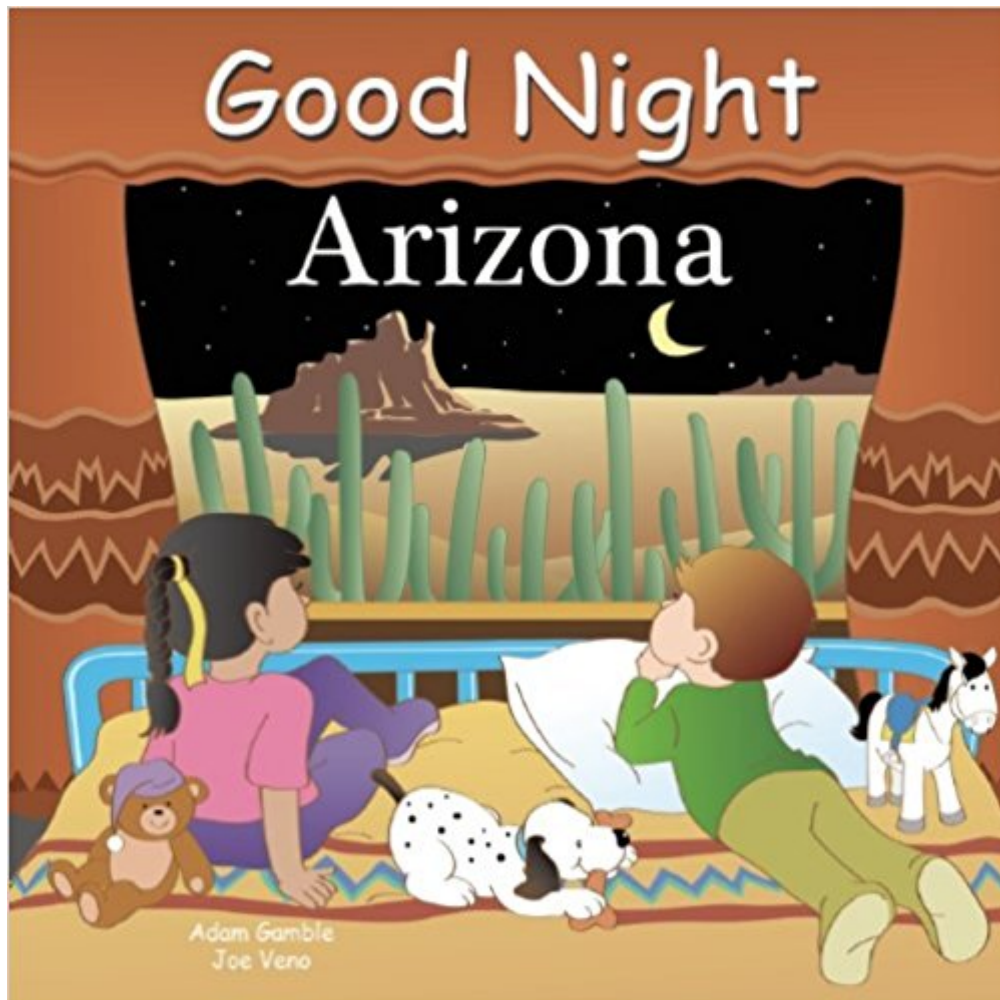

What makes the books really special are the illustrations because they are full of things to talk about with kids. And, when kids get to the age that they want to tell stories, they can talk about all of the things they see even if they can't read. The books usually highlight famous areas or attractions, animals and activities in each geographical location. I was so excited when I got this book because I was expecting to see things my sons could relate to in our new state. Unfortunately, this book is huge disappointment. First of all, the illustrations are very basic, almost amateur. Instead of being full of things to talk about, the illustrations are about just what is written. Instead of having lots of interesting things to see, the book is full of "lists
