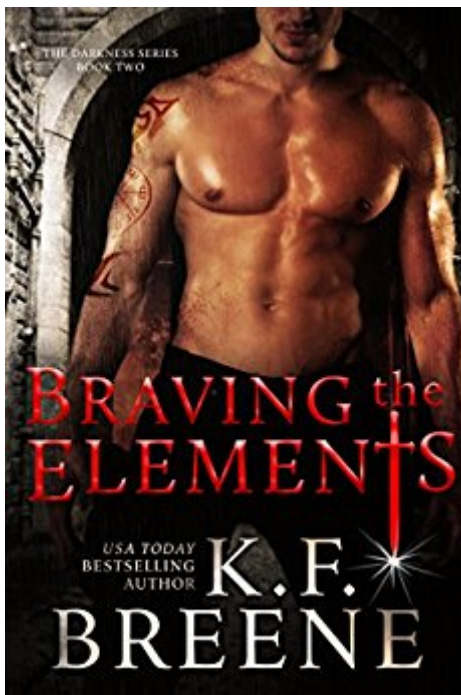


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Braving The Elements (Darkness #2)

Four and a half stars, actually. Most excellent follow-up to the opening book of this series. I had my fingers crossed because some of the other reviews were really negative but after reading this book in one sleepless night I can only attribute those reviews to differences in tastes and expectations.

What did I like best about this installment?
