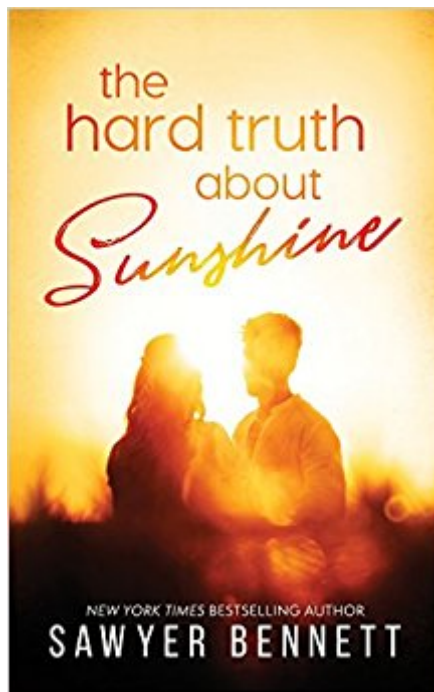


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The Hard Truth About Sunshine

I'll admit that at first, being blind myself, I was irritated that Jillian was predominantly characterized by her drooping eyes. In past, many have noticed my nystagmus, or dancing eyes, and shied away; they thought I was a space case, maybe even thought I was high, and asked stupid questions that hurt my feelings. But I realize now that two things have happened here: Christopher does not shy away from Jillian's differences, and the main reason he focuses so much on Jillian's eyes in the first place is because he can't get past his own disfigurement. Makes sense, doesn't it? But Jillian's

eyes, personality, and outlook are endeared to him throughout the story, and Christopher's falling in love with her, his observation of her self-acceptance, and his recognition of her as a person beyond her disability end up being partially responsible for his advancement in the grief process and greater confidence in himself as a disabled person. I loved this book. It made me laugh and cry by turns, and I was on the road right there with Christopher, Jillian, Barb, and Connor. Bennett writes the characters in such a way that I became truly invested in them and related to each personally, finding a piece of myself in each because each represents a spin on the grief experience. Jillian represents hope and acceptance, sometimes even denial, but in the end learns she can feel sad, angry, or even afraid without fear of being a fake or losing herself and her outlook. Similarly, Connor embodies acceptance. He has to, in a way, because his circumstances won't change; but nonetheless he is courageous in allowing himself to live in the moment, whether that moment is in joy or sorrow. Christopher, of course, represents anger and depression but eventually learns hope and acceptance. And poor Barb, who I think is my favorite, experiences depression and anger like Christopher does, but although she doesn't reach acceptance in as conventional a way, I truly believe she comes to terms with things the best she can. She transcends what people understand bravery to be. I'm no stranger with the grief process, so I read all of these things naturally. Even so, sometimes even the highest self-awareness can't touch the despair clawing at your heart. You just have to extricate yourself from grief's clutches in whichever way you can, and every process has been slightly different for me as a result. I think Bennett illustrates this concept beautifully. There's a universality to grief, and yet everyone experiences it uniquely; even the same person might experience different losses in different ways. The release of this novel was very timely for me, and I will treasure it.

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
