

terms and subjects of American high schools in my new acquired language, english (I graduated high school in 2011). Since I failed the test once, the AFQT to be exact. I understood the equations on all the math problems but not the questions, not to a hundred percent that it. So I decided to give this book a chance, and surprisingly, in only a few pages, I re-learned, or better said, it took my mind to the past, and made me remember all that math stuff I had forgotten. Of course, it became a great study guide for the other subjects of the ASVAB and the AFQT. Now I feel more than ready to take the military exam.I will update after I actually take it, to let you know about the improvements.

Quick study with easy to learn instructions helped me pass the test. I'm headed to the AirForce

Family member has taken the test and scored very well. They indicated that this was a very helpful guide, as the ASVAB is a different kind of test than the SAT or ACT (which they had also taken). It was helpful to review the sections and understand the types of questions along with getting in the right mindset.The content of this book is very informative. Each section of the ASVAB is addressed with an introductory section, guidelines for tackling each type of question, practice questions and the answers and explanations for each practice question.There are practice tests: ASVAB all 9 sections x three practice exams.....AND the 4 sections of the AFQT portion of the test x two practice exams. Therefore you get five practice tests for the AFQT portion of the test.The guide ends with summary information on what contributes to test failure, tips for doing well overall, and ways to boost your Math and English skills.The Appendix (18 pages long) is titled "Matching ASVAB Scores to Military Jobs". This includes all branches: Army, Air Force, Navy, Marines, and Coast Guard.

I have to re-take a portion of my ASVAB in order to apply to a certain program. I needed to improve my math skills (AR- Arithmetic Reasoning), and this book was very highly regarded on . I was very impressed to see how organized this book is, and I was able to jump right to the section of the book that I needed to pay attention to. I feel confident that this is going to really help me improve my math skills according to the ASVAB.

A lot of info to help you prepare yourself for the ASVAB! It helped me refresh my memories for mathematics formulas, root words, etc. Don't burn yourself trying to memorize everything in this textbook/study guide since you won't be needing to know everything for the ASVAB. Hahaha. I'll point this out for anyone that is interested in joining the service. Remember, the ASVAB is to test you for your knowledge to see what job areas you are compatible with. Lets say that you want to

work on Humvees and vehicles for the Army. You would need to study more in your shop/equipments and mechanical. If you score high in that section, you're going to have a lot of job title which you can apply for mechanical. If you tank in that section, you will be having job titles for admin, and other jobs that aren't mechanical. I joined the Air Force and I knew that I wanted to do electrical work / diagnosis for the planes. So I reviewed much more on the electrical, mechanical and shop sections!

Got a 95 AFQT and with my line scores I could pretty much just pick my MOS. :)

I'm 25 and been out of school for the past 4 years. So as you could imagine I am very rusty when it comes to math and arithmetic, this book was a great refresher and it definitely covers almost everything you'll need to know about the asvab and the military prior to mepsHowever it seems to be mostly common knowledge and very basic information. But I can say it definitely helps if you feel like you need to be studying for the asvab. If your fresh out of high school or college I'd say just get some asvab apps (usually free on play store or iOS) and study that way. But if you were like me and haven't had to take tests in years then this might be worth it.4*'s only cause this one is old now, they have a 2016/17 issue now
