

I'm a pastor. People are often asking me, "How do I know what God's will is for my life?" They think of God's will as path that is difficult to find and easy to wonder off once one is on it. In truth, God's will is to share life with us. Discernment is how we recognize God near us, nudging, guiding, healing, and enriching us. The whole Companions in Christ series helps us to recognize God sharing life with us, but The Way of Discernment is particularly helpful in how to recognize and then respond to the leadership of the Holy Spirit in one's life. I have done a lot of reading in this area and the Way of Discernment is intensely practical and accessible while not skimping a bit on this life long journey of learning how to recognize God beside us. Can't recommend it enough. It is a good resource for group study of anyone desiring how to sense the leading of the Holy Spirit in their lives, as well as for leadership teams endeavoring to follow as Jesus leads their church.
