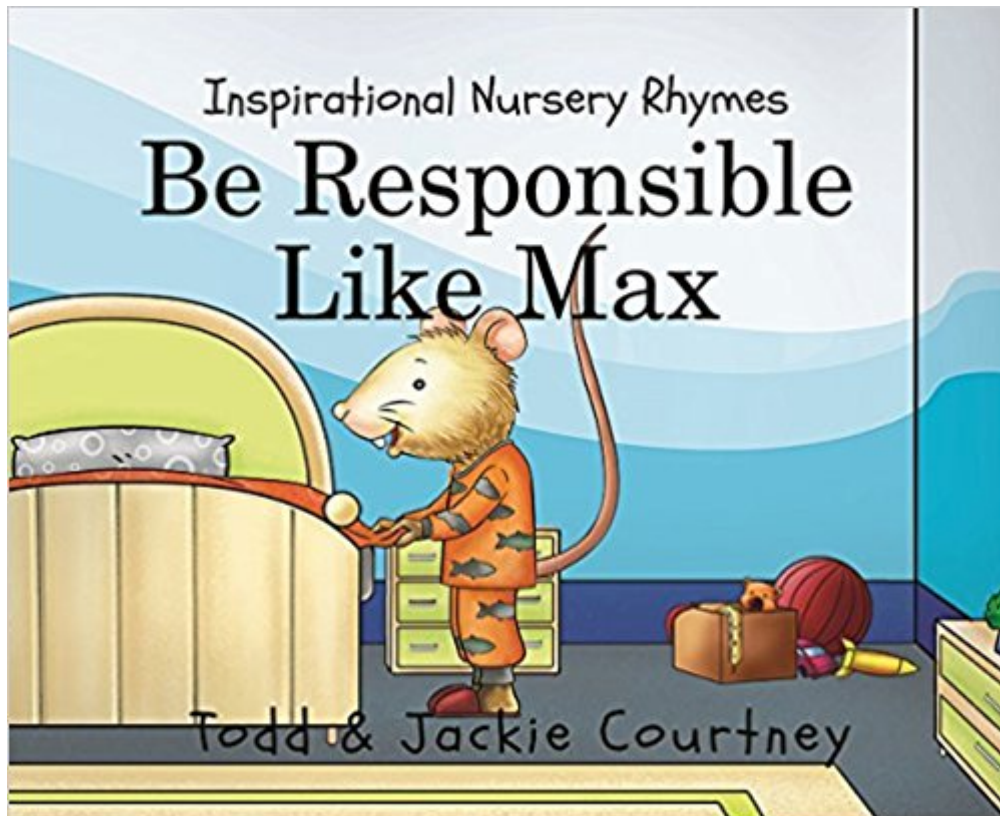

What a concept! Letting kids know that they can and should be responsible for things like making

To make changes, we must teach our children, and brain science tells us that the best time to teach children is from birth to age seven -- or even in utero, since babies recognize words, sounds and feelings while in the womb. There's a new series of cute board books featuring easy-to-remember rhymes for little ones featuring Max, his little sister Molly and other adorable animal characters. Written by Todd and Jackie Courtney to create a positive belief system and positive self-image, they even call the books "self-help books for toddlers!" I checked out "Be Responsible like Max" and am loving it. I plan to gift it to a special little kid I know.
