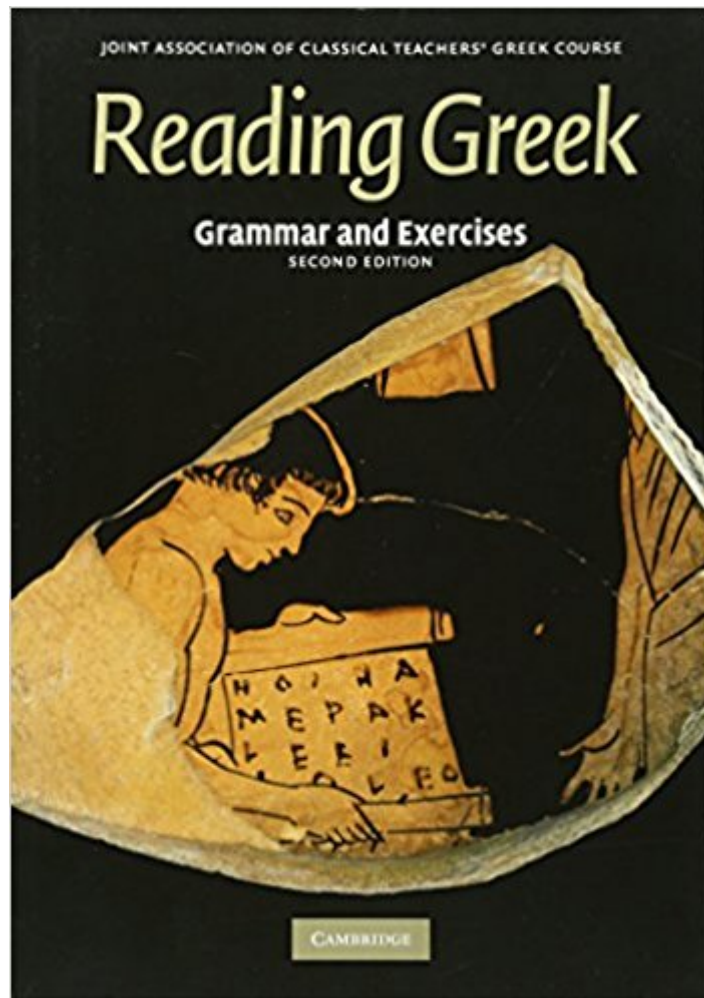


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Reading Greek: Grammar And Exercises



Synopsis

First published in 1978, Reading Greek has become a best-selling one-year introductory course in ancient Greek for students and adults. It combines the best of modern and traditional language-learning techniques and is used widely in schools, summer schools and universities across the world. It has also been translated into several foreign languages. This volume provides full grammatical support together with numerous exercises at different levels. For the second edition the presentations of grammar have been substantially revised to meet the needs of today's students and the volume has been completely redesigned, with the use of colour. Greek-English and English-Greek vocabularies are provided, as well as a substantial reference grammar and language surveys. The accompanying Text and Vocabulary volume contains a narrative adapted entirely from ancient authors in order to encourage students rapidly to develop their reading skills, simultaneously receiving a good introduction to Greek culture.

A good book for introduction to Greek. The author does a good job explaining most of the grammatical phenomena that you will experience in Greek, however at times he is a bit terse in his explanations and examples, especially towards the back of the textbook (The hortatory, preventative, and deliberative subjunctive, for example). Other than that, it pairs really nicely with his Text and Vocabulary textbook, and will get you up to a point where you are able to read some Plato and Homer with only a little bit of external help.

I have the Kindle version of "Reading Greek: Grammar & Exercises" and it's perfectly fine. When accented, the lowercase upsilon looks slightly off--it's below the baseline and a bit larger than the other characters--but it's not a problem. My only complaint is that some of the charts are on the small side. The Kindle version of the Text & Vocabulary volume may still have issues however. I don't own it, but I previewed it using the "Look Inside" feature, and there are definitely problems with the Greek font. By the way, I recommend the Grammar even for those not working their way through the JACT course. Sections B and C are a reference grammar and language survey that will serve anyone who wants a well-organized, even entertaining, review.

This book is very clearly written and gives explanations of forms and grammar that are quite easy to understand. Highly technical language is avoided which helps the student to grasp the concepts apart from wrestling with complicated nomenclature. The exercises offered are continuous and plentiful, offering many opportunities to work on those issues that demand more work.

I was excited to get this series for kindle-only to find that the text (Part 1) is not on the kindle. What's the deal!? The grammar and exercises and the answer key are on the kindle but not the reading text? *Update, now available on Kindle, though some complain of formatting issues...boo.

The audio CDs are Also Good for non-english speaking people. But as a foreigner, the textbooks are not good enough , especially to a self-learning people. The books of the same series have too short explanations which needs a teacher. In that aspect, I recommend the Madtrona book to self-learning people as a textbook.

NEVER buy the electronic version. It is hideously and inconveniently formatted -- doesn't even have page numbers.

Together with the Text and Vocabulary, this book takes advantage of modern language teaching methods. Although the books are geared for reading, the student reinforces reading ability with texts that are easy to visualize and with listening that adds to fluency. The student can further reinforce learning with writing exercises provided and with the student's recording texts in his/her own voice. Apparently the authors realize the limitations of the grammar-translation method for the majority of learners and in these books have achieved what needed to be done. Dr. Eli Ben-Joseph

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
