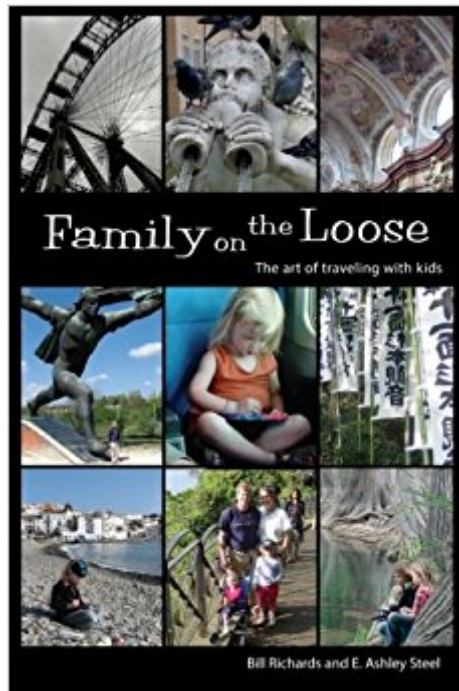

All I can say is that I wish I had this book 10 years ago. I've got two kids, and we have traveled a fair bit with them, but it is always a challenge to keep them engaged and interested. This book covers guidelines and helpful tips for travelling with kids from the early stages of planning a trip to packing to airports to the plane to the trip itself. It doesn't tell you where you should go to appease the kids, it helps your kids enjoy the sites that the adults want to go to, including museums, cultural and historical sites. Every chapter is full of great suggestions - some of the sidebars are really helpful: "Fourteen Quiet Activities for the Plane" or "A Dozen Games While You are Waiting" (for food, or a bus, etc). There is so much to be gained from travelling with your kids and this book helps to prove that it doesn't need to be so scary.

We love traveling with our kids, who are currently 9 & 10 years old. We are planning long term travel, international travel and will also begin homeschooling our kids soon. This book gave great ideas on everything from packing to preparing kids for travel and getting their involvement. The ideas can be modified for all ages of kids. We've already used some of the tips on preparation through the local library. We are preparing for a trip to the United Kingdom and have gotten the kids very involved in the research and planning (history & activities). I loved the section on how to keep the travel bug alive at home - before and after the trip. The "mini trip" ideas and tips on exploring your own town or city were great. I look forward to using this resource for homeschooling also. I read this book cover to cover, and bookmarked lots of pages for reference.

We have travelled a lot with our kids, but thought this might have some new ideas. It has tons! As a seasoned traveller I skimmed over some of the more basic sections, although they would have been very useful when we first started. Other chapters I poured over slowly and took notes. The authors provide advice that can be used by all different kinds of people, in all different types of travel from local trips to international expeditions. It might actually be too much to use all the suggestions, but

each reader will be able to take what they want and improve the quality of his or her next adventure with the kids.

Furthermore, emphasizing how much everyone can learn from every travel experience and then giving excellent suggestions of how to "make the memories stick" goes a long way in making "citizens of the world." This book should find an important place on bookshelves of folks who love to travel.

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
