

Conrad Phillip Kottak (A.B. Columbia, 1963; Ph.D. Columbia, 1966) is Professor and Chair of Anthropology at the University of Michigan, where he has taught since 1968. In 1991 he was honored for his teaching by the University and the state of Michigan. In 1992 he received an excellence in teaching award from the College of Literature, Sciences, and the Arts of the University of Michigan. Professor Kottak has done fieldwork in cultural anthropology in Brazil (since 1962), Madagascar (since 1966), and the United States. In current research projects, Kottak and his

colleagues have investigated the emergence of ecological awareness in Brazil, the social context of deforestation in Madagascar, and popular participation in economic development planning in northeastern Brazil.

Used it for a 1st-year Intro to Anthro class. It's kind of got some personal anecdotal stuff about Kottak's travels and work, so it's got personal reflection and observation throughout. But Kottak does inform on all the principals in the development of anthropology as a science. There was a fairly obvious liberal bias in favor of globalism and acceptance of global warming and other moderately suspect new world science. It was necessary to just parrot the answers back to my instructor from the pages.

I was very happy with the overall experience I had with this text book. I received the book on time for my class and it was in perfect condition. I recommend that you save the original packaging that it comes in if you are planning on returning the book (if you rent the book instead of purchasing as I did). The return process is also very simple and easy to do. I would for sure recommend this product to anybody in need of the book!

The book was listed as acceptable. Everything seems alright until I am told to read certain pages of the book, come to find out the kindle for PC version has no page numbers. It only has locations which are far from helpful, due the quantity of them and no way of knowing what parts of the book are associated with that location. I wanted to get the actual book after finding this out but now I discover I can't return Kindle books after 7 days, and I'm not going to spend a total of \$210 for an eBook which is hard to read and a big thick physical text book, both of which I won't use after this course. If you need this as a text book for a class, I recommend just going with the physical copy in some way, stay away from this eBook.
