

Hickling is a Registered Nurse who has been teaching sexual education for over 25 years. She is an outstanding educator, and her ability to convey difficult material with sensitivity, gentle humour and warmth distinguishes her as a remarkable teacher and role model. In this latest publication, Hickling brings her award-winning lesson into the homes, schools and libraries of inquisitive children everywhere!

Very happy with this for my 8 year old. Most of the writing seemed to be geared towards younger kids, but I read aloud and she didn't seem to mind. She seemed to identify with the "gross!" mentality, and she thought the teacher's instructions to say "interesting!" instead was funny.... And it worked. She was a little bored by some of the basic body part stuff, but she did learn more details in a very non-awkward way. Nobody turned red in the reading of this book. And there was just one page on the "birds and bees" stuff, which is what she's been asking questions about, but I think it was enough for the first intro. We used it as a jumping-off point, and it was very easy to continue talking and answering more questions. I think, depending on what you want to share, this would also work for kids as young as 5. The writing style is geared towards that age. Just read it first.

A very down to earth book on the facts of life that seemed to cover everything in a very age appropriate scientific factual way. I did have the book "Where did I come from" for my 19yr old when she was at that age, but reviewing it for my 9yr old daughter I found myself asking "what was I thinking?!" this book is one I won't be scared to hand to my boys when they get to "That age"

This book is great! It saved me from certain disaster. My 5.5 year old daughter was repeatedly asking me where babies come from. I tried the generic answers and then tried telling her she'd find out when she got older, but she was having none of that. So, I had to figure out how to explain it to her in a way she would understand. Coincidentally, she wants to be a scientist when she grows up so she connected with the book since it focuses on explaining our bodies in scientific terms. We've read it many, many times already. At first, I kept her in the first half of the book - learning about body parts and what they do. Once she understood that, we moved to the second half of the book - how babies are made. I understand that some kids aren't ready to learn this, so we had a long talk prior to reading the book that this is not information to share at school or with friends for now. Overall, I'm very happy with this purchase! We completely skipped over the awkward birds and bees talk. Whew!!

What a fantastic book. Great explanations & perfect for an 8 1/2 year old. Great use of dialogue in the story between nurse & students giving good answers to questions you would expect from young children on this topic. I can recommend it to all parents of young children.

A little more scientific/ mature/detailed info than what I expected, but I am happy with the straightforward explanations for the most part. Seems like the publisher/author may have sketched over a few things in an effort not to offend or shock but otherwise it is acceptable.

I ordered a few books in order to find one that would be appropriate to have THAT talk with my girls, aged 6 and 8. The others will provide more detailed information as the girls get older, but for now, this book will be perfect. They are very curious and I have always taken a matter-of-fact approach to topics like breastfeeding and how babies come out (which my 6 year old wanted to know about in extreme detail at 3 years old!!) so I think this will suit that style perfectly. It is humorous, and it shows the kids that different reactions to learning about this potentially awkward topic are normal. I am planning on reading it with them on the weekend, and I'm actually looking forward to it!!
