

As you might expect with an anthology, the stories vary in quality of writing and creativity. But I enjoyed most of them. It was interesting to read the authors who influenced them and where their story ideas came from. I would like to give this volume a score of 3.5 but half points aren't available.

There are two reasons why I highly recommend this book. 1. There is a common underlying theme - wormholes. The different approach each author takes to this hypothetical structure keeps the reader intrigued. 2. There were only two "clunkers", at least for my taste. I was left wanting more.

I found the first two stories in this collection to be interesting and entertaining. Unfortunately, I can't

say the same thing about the other stories. They all focused too much on future conflicts with malevolent aliens and too little on the exploration and science related to the discovery of a wormhole. I would have preferred more investigation of the wonders associated with the revelation that wormholes do exist and less far in the future combat between civilizations.

I haven't read a book of short stories in years, simply because I don't find them compelling. I thought I'd give this book a try, and I have not changed. I simply don't like this format. If you like short stories, this will appeal to you. This is simply another case of 'it's not you, it's me.'
