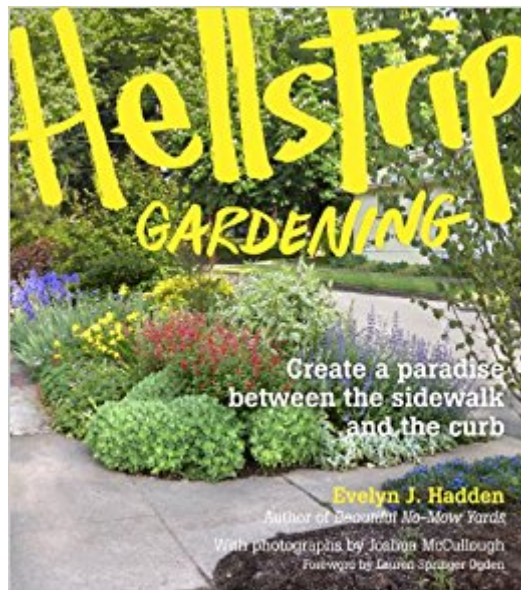




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Hellstrip Gardening: Create A Paradise Between The Sidewalk And The Curb

I love this book! Evelyn has an informal, folksy way of writing that is engaging and fun. The book is divided up into short chapters so it’s a good one to pick up when you have just a few minutes between chores and appointments, etc. The examples are awesome and cover a wide variety of conditions, zones and affinities. These principles can be applied to anyone’s garden whether they have a “hellstrip” or not. I highly recommend this book.

This book seems to be written more as a guide for folks who are already familiar with things like botanical names, hardiness zones, and how to lay out and nurture a garden. I’m thoroughly enjoying this book and find it a valuable resource. Each chapter showcases a specific garden in a different region of the country. The last several sections deal with potential zoning issues, water issues, line

of sight issues, things of that nature. It's not a how-to, in that it doesn't give a template for a garden with directions to plant one of this type here and 3 of that type there. I highly recommend this book as a resource for tackling hell-strips, it's a fun read.
