

My 9 yr old daughter is quite mature for her age and extremely smart, so it might be better for a bit older age group, as there are a few, very rare, minor cuss words here and there throughout the

series (literally like 4 in ALL the books, combined) and it's got the tiny bit of romance, but we loved the books!! The best parts are how Harriet deals with her stress and her feelings, how she communicates (or doesn't), and the way she remains true to herself. It really helped, in my opinion, my daughter see that she's not the only person that has these types of thoughts and feelings...everyone does! She isn't alone in feeling awkward...according to her, I'm her mom, so I have to tell her that - but these books showed her that I'm not just saying it because I'm her mom. :-) The books are well written and vivid. The descriptions are spot on and really allow you to "see" the story - some of the outfits are hilarious!! The language is appropriate for tween-teenage girls and they can connect to the book and become engrossed, even though it's British and we are in the US. I'm really glad that I found these to share with my little girl!
