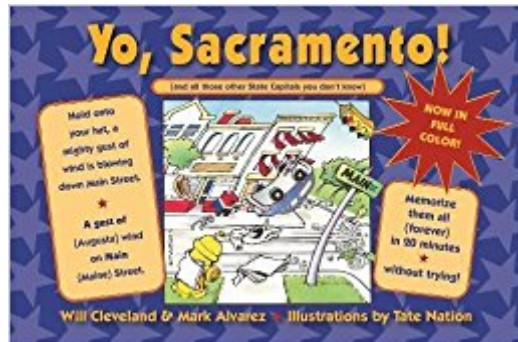

We studied approximately 10 states a week - the book is organized into regions and next year I will be following the book's regions to make things easier. Just a heads up about Idaho and Alaska. The Idaho picture is "boys eating hoes" which caused a few giggles and the Alaska picture has a reference to Vodka which also caused murmurs because they knew it was inappropriate for school. My students loved the book and there was a big difference in test scores before using the book and after using the book.
