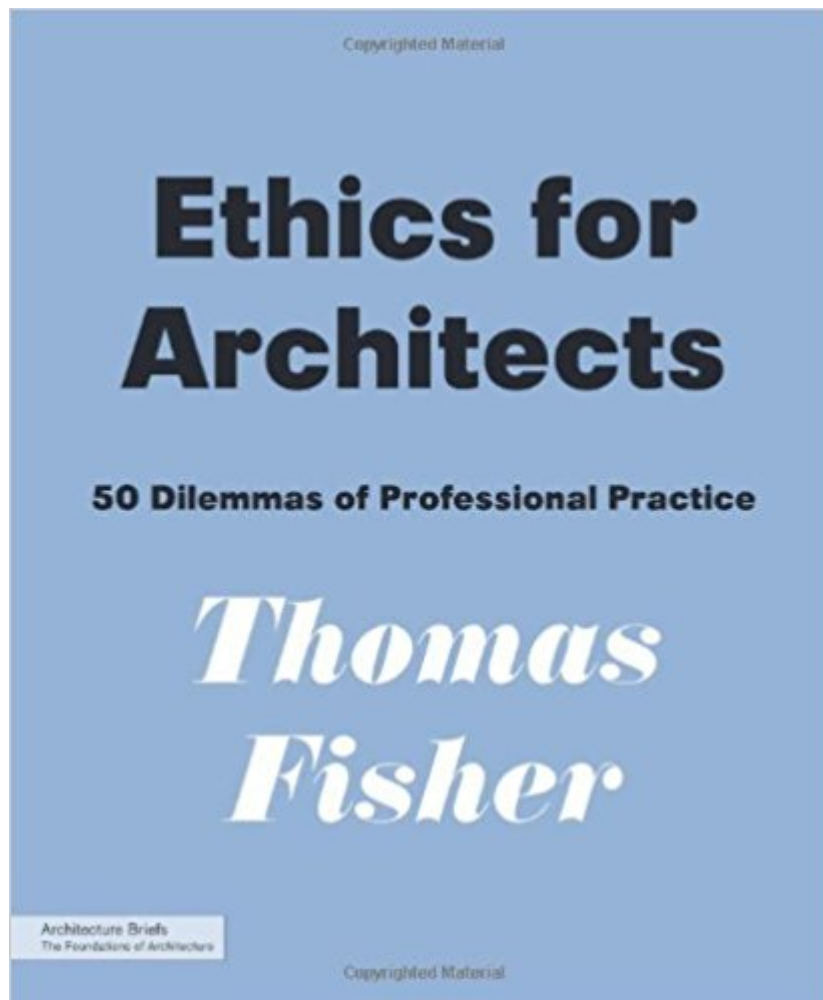




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Ethics For Architects: 50 Dilemmas Of Professional Practice (Architecture Briefs)
